INTRODUCTION

Aerial Gymnastics and Cheer Browns Plains Inc takes great pride in the presentation and representation of the club. The following uniform requirements have been endorsed to ensure all members of our team wear the appropriate attire to participate in activities safely, are easily identified as club members; and represent our club in a positive and professional manner.

This document has been created in line with [Gymnastics Australia's Uniform Policy](#). It is recommended clubs refer to this when making additions/changes to this document to avoid conflict with the policy.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

COACHES

During training, Coaches are required to wear:

- Club polo shirt
- Club shorts (provided)
- Club tracksuit (provided) – optional
- White socks and runners
- Hair tied back neatly
- Form fitting cultural headwear
- Any activewear that matches club colours

During competition, Coaches are required to wear:

- Club polo shirt (provided)
- Club tracksuit (provided)
- White socks and runners
- Hair tied back neatly
- Form fitting cultural headwear

GYMNASTS

All Gymnastic Programs

Gymnasts participating in Gymnastic programs are required to wear:

- Comfortable clothing (i.e. T-Shirt and Shorts (must be close-fitting or tucked in)) or Bike pants, leggings and crop top, singlet, Leotard or form fitting cultural headwear. Buttons and zips not allowed.
- Hair tied back neatly
- No socks
- Competition - Club leotard, bike pants (optional), club tracksuit jacket and pants, white socks, hair tied up in high bun with club scrunchie.

Cheerleaders

Cheerleaders participating in Cheerleading programs are required to wear:

- Comfortable clothing (i.e. T-Shirt and Shorts (must be close-fitting or tucked in)) or Bike pants, leggings and crop top, singlet, Leotard or form fitting cultural headwear. Buttons and zips not allowed.
- Hair tied back neatly
- Socks and shoes
- Competition - Club uniform, club tracksuit jacket and pants (optional), club polo/baseball jersey (optional) white socks and white shoes, hair tied up in high ponytail with club scrunchie.

Travelling

We encourage clubs to consider the type of travel athletes will be undertaking as this may influence the type or need for uniforms.

When gymnasts are travelling to and from events, competitions or public displays, the following uniform should be worn:

- Club Polo Shirt/Club T-Shirt
- Black shorts
- Club tracksuit (if necessary)
- Socks and runners
- Hair tied back neatly
- Form fitting cultural headwear

JUDGES

Judges are required to wear the uniform specified by their respective Technical Committee.

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteer uniforms are dependent on the environment and role, volunteers who help with the day to day running of the Club and are in public view for promotional work will be provided with one Club Polo/T-shirt shirt to be worn neatly on these occasions.
